You can send recurring electronic invoices to customers, accept flat-rate ACH payments, track invoice payment status, send automatic payment reminders and overdue notices to keep customers' prompt. It seamlessly syncs with your bookkeeping software, like Quickbooks, Xero, etc for faster and accurate reconciliations.

**Pricing :** Starts from \$39 per month

## 7. Toggl – Time tracking on projects made easier than ever

This cloud-based tool makes employee time-tracking so much easier. If you are in an industry that bills clients on an hourly basis, Toggl might be just the tool you need.

With its unified interface, you can get a visual overview of key project metrics.

The tool integrates with various other platforms like calendar apps so your employees can directly convert various events into time entries. Its reporting module lets businesses generate daily, weekly or monthly reports and gain insights into employees' activities.
